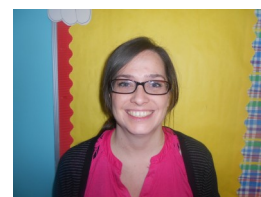
New Faces at TCEP

letter highlighting the themes and activities that the students will be working on. We are also expanding

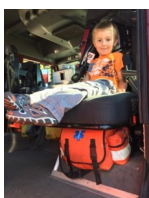
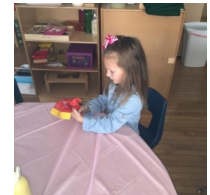


into electronic modes of communi-

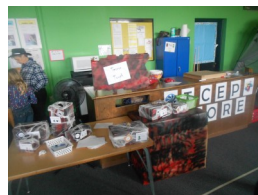
